The Civil engineering department has been in existence since the establishment of this institute. The department has an excellent infrastructure and is AICTE approved. CED has faculty with specialization in environmental engineering, geotechnical engineering, structural engineering, transportation engineering, water resources engineering, materials engineering, Hydraulics and Fluid Mechanics, surveying, and construction engineering.

Apart from the undergraduate course, postgraduate courses offered in construction management and structural engineering. The department is approved by university of Mumbai for the Ph. D. program with an intake capacity of 45.

In addition, the department is selected as a QIP Centre by the AICTE. AICTE provides full financial assistantship for three years to the research scholars registered under QIP. Also, department can conduct number of short term courses in the area of civil engineering and complete financial assistantship will be provided by AICTE.
