Alumni Meet 2018 was organized by Mechanical Engineering Department, Sardar Patel College of Engineering under Industry-Institute Interaction, TEQIP III on **27.11.2018** from (6 pm till 10 pm) in the seminar hall room no 119. The meet was attended by more than 42 Alumni delegates from various batches and the faculties of Mechanical Engg. Dept. The objective being to reinforce a sense of belongingness towards their alumni association, fostering the spirit of fellowship and providing a common platform for social and intellectual interaction.



The Inaugural Ceremony of Alumni meet was conducted by lightening of lamp and Sarsawati Vandan. Dr. M. M. MURUDI, Vice-Principal, addressed the audience with his inaugural speech and enlightened the audience about TEQIP activities. Dr. Rajesh Butkar, Dean of Academics, presented the changes made in the curriculum as per emerging Industry 4.0 requirements and how the IOT and VR technologies can be implemented for the training of students. He further emphasized on the merger of industry relevant online courses available such as IOT, Machine learning, VR with the academic syllabus to give students more insights about the industry in order to fill the gap existing between industry and academics.
