## **NOTICE**

All students seeking hostel accommodation for the **Academic Year 2026–27** at **SPCE – Hostel** (Boys & Girls) are required to submit their applications online through the **Qviple application** between **15<sup>th</sup> July to 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2026**. The application window will remain open only for the stipulated period. Any student who fails to apply within this timeframe will be required to wait until the entire admission process is completed.

The **1<sup>st</sup> merit list** of the selected candidates will be published on the institute's official website on **24<sup>th</sup> July 2026**. Simultaneously, confirmation of accepted applications will also be made available. Selected candidates will be able to view the applicable hostel fees and complete the payment process online through the **Qviple application**.

The **2<sup>nd</sup> Merit List** will be displayed after the **results of the re-examinations are announced**.

From this year, to make the hostel admission process paperless, all students are hereby informed to fill in all the details mentioned in Qviple, **including all the undertakings. Uploading current photograph, digital signatures, etc.** (No need to download the hostel form or any undertaking through the website or printing of undertaking on a ₹100/- stamp paper)

Regarding the **Hostel Fee Structure** students are requested to refer to the notice for the newly introduced **Performance-Linked Hostel Fee Discount Scheme**.

After completing all the required details in the **Qviple** application, students must also upload / attach the relevant supporting documents, wherever applicable. These may include:

- Semester Grade Card
- Attendance Certificate generated from Qviple
- NPTEL / Industry Certification(s)
- GATE Scorecard
- Internship Completion Letter
- Sports, Cultural, or Research Participation Certificates
- Any other relevant supporting documents, as applicable

The submitted application form and supporting documents will be verified by the Administration. Based on the verification and the eligibility criteria under the **Performance-Linked Hostel Fee Discount Scheme**, the applicable fee discount will be calculated, and the final hostel fee payable will be reflected for the student before payment. Hence, all students are hereby advised to carefully read the instructions and ensure compliance with all the requirements specified in the application form. Failure to furnish the required information or supporting documents, or to comply with the prescribed guidelines, may result in rejection of the application for the **Performance-Linked Hostel Fee Discount**.

Acceptance of the **Hostel Form** in person shall commence from **29<sup>th</sup> July 2026**. Rooms will be allotted to students in accordance with the prescribed accommodation plan. Room allotment shall be carried out strictly on a **First Come First In** basis. Requests for room preference, change, or selection will not be entertained under any circumstances.

Selected students are required to report in person to the Hostel Office and submit the following documents:

- Printing of filled **Hostel Form - Hostel Copy** through Qviple.
- The **Qviple-generated fee receipt**.
- Hostel Mess Charges are to be paid separately.

The acceptance of Hostel Forms and room allocation shall be carried out as per the plan mentioned below.

Students whose hostel accommodation has been duly approved may arrive not earlier than 1–2 days prior to 29<sup>th</sup> July 2026. Arrival before this period will not be permitted under any circumstances. Therefore, all students are advised to plan their travel and ticket bookings accordingly.

Upon arrival at the hostel, students must present their hostel accommodation approval/acceptance letter and fee receipt to the security personnel for verification. This will help avoid any inconvenience or delay during entry to the hostel premises.

Students who arrive prior to the notified hostel room allocation date, or whose hostel applications have not been approved through the **Qviple** application, shall not be permitted entry into the hostel premises. Such students are advised to contact the Hostel Office or the Faculty In-charge for further guidance regarding their accommodation.

Further, as per the **Hostel Rules and Regulations** and the decision of the Institute Administration, students (Boys / Girls) who were found guilty of examination malpractice during the **Academic Year 2025–26** shall not be eligible for hostel accommodation for the **Academic Year 2026–27**. Such students are advised to make alternative accommodation arrangements well in advance to avoid any inconvenience to them and to facilitate the smooth administration of hostel admissions.

This notice is issued for all students to strictly adhere to the guidelines stated above. Students are hereby instructed to take due note and ensure full compliance. No requests or exceptions will be entertained in the event of failure to follow these instructions. Students are advised to avoid any such situations.

For **Parents /Guardians**: are requested to verify and confirm the above-mentioned details with their wards and to plan their travel accordingly, so as to avoid any inconvenience or unforeseen circumstances. **The involvement of parents/guardians from this year onward is intended to ensure adherence to the guidelines.**
