Institute-Level Counselling Round for M. Tech. Admissions against Vacant Seats after CAP – AY 2026–27

Institute Level Counselling Round for admissions to the First Year M. Tech Programmes for the Academic Year 2026-27, against the vacant seats after CAP-IV Round of the Maharashtra State CET Cell for admission, will be conducted as per the details given below.

The details of the seats remaining vacant after CAP Round-IV will be published on the website by 08.09.2026. The vacancy position may dynamically change on every day of the counselling round.

Instructions:

1. Only the candidates registered online through CET portal and verified their application before cut-off date, are eligible.
2. These admissions will be made strictly in the order of inter-se merit amongst the candidates who have applied through in the form available on the college website for counselling round at <https://forms.gle/2tjKEVDSTfqmCr3x8> this link and report in person for the counselling rounds on the dates given above.
3. The candidate will need to pay a registration fee (Non-Refundable) of **Rs. 2,000/- through online mode (Bank Account Details are mentioned on point no. 9) & transaction ID/ UTR No.** to be mention in the registration form. **Candidates applying through the CET Cell shall pay the Counselling Round Registration Fee after reporting to the Institute.**
4. The candidate will lose the claim to participate in the admission counselling process if he/she fails to produce all the applicable original documents at the time of document verification during the Counselling round. In case a candidate has taken admission elsewhere, he/she will be required to produce the original fee receipt, the Original Admission Confirmation Letter of that institute and submit one self-attested photo copy of each document.
5. After successful verification of the relevant original document, further eligible candidates will be called for seat allotment by counselling as per inter-se merit.
6. At the time of seat allotment by counselling, the candidate is required to submit "Requisition for Seat Allotment."
7. The seat allotment will be carried out based on the vacancy status at the time of candidates reporting to the counselling round. Accordingly, the seat allotted to a candidate would then be deleted from the pool of vacant seats displayed on the auditorium screen. Candidates are advised to be present in the Counselling Hall and wait for their turn as per inter-se merit. If a candidate is not available when called, the next candidate on the merit list would be called for allotment of seat and the absent candidate may miss his/her chance of merit-based seat allotment.

8. However, if a candidate of higher merit reports late during the process of counselling, and seeks admission against seats vacant (of a particular category to which he/she belongs) at the time of reporting, would get a preference for admission over the candidates with lower rank present at that point of time. The decision of the admission centre In-charge shall be final and binding in this regard.
9. Confirmation of the allotted seat to the candidate is subject to the submission of the requisite Institute admission fees. The candidate is required to pay fees through a Demand Draft in favour of “**Principal, SPCE, PG A/c**” payable at Mumbai and through online to the following Bank Details:

Part Payment or Payment through cash/cheque will not be accepted under any circumstances.
11. Candidates already admitted to SPCE in CAP Rounds, in the F. Y. M. Tech. Programme for AY 2026-27, who are aspiring for branch change should also remain present in person and furnish the original admission confirmation letter issued by SPCE. They need not pay the above-mentioned fees.
12. Mere participation in the Counselling Round and paying the registration cannot be construed as a guarantee of confirmation of admission in the Institute.
