Notification Regarding S.Y. (Direct) B. Tech. Institute Level / Counselling /Spot Round Admissions for AY 2025-26

Institute level Direct Counselling (Spot) Round for admissions to the Second Year (Direct Admission) Engineering Programmes (B. Tech. Civil, Mechanical, Electrical Engg.) for the Academic Year 2025-26 against the vacant seats after CAP-IV Round of the Maharashtra State CET Cell for admission, will be conducted (as per the reference Rule No. 13 mentioned in the Information Brochure for the academic year 2025-26 published by State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra State) as per the details given.

Date of Round: 13 September, 2025

The details of the seats remaining vacant after CAP Round-IV will be published on the website of the institute by 13.09.2025 by 2.00 pm. The vacancy position may dynamically change on every day of the counselling round.

Instructions:

- 1. Only the candidates registered online through CET portal and verified their application before cut-off date, are eligible. New applications will not be considered.
- 2. These admissions will be made strictly in the order of inter-se merit amongst the candidates who have registered and reported in person for the counselling rounds on the date given above.
- 3. The candidate will need to pay in cash registration / application processing fee of Rs. 1500/- for unreserved category and Rs. 1000/- for Reserved category.
- 4. The candidate will lose the claim to participate in the admission counselling process if he/she fails to produce all the applicable original documents at the time of document verification during the Counselling round. In case a candidate has taken admission elsewhere, he/she will be required to produce the original fees receipt, the Original Admission Confirmation Letter of that institute and submit one self-attested photo copy of each document.
- 5. After successful verification of the relevant original document, further eligible candidates will be called for seat allotment by counselling as per inter-se merit.
- 6. At the time of seat allotment by counselling, the candidate is required to submit "Requisition for Seat Allotment."
- 7. The seat allotment will be carried out based on the vacancy status at the time of candidates reporting to the counselling round (as per the reference Rule No. 13

mentioned in the Information Brochure for the academic year 2025-26 published by State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra State). Accordingly, the seat allotted to a candidate would then be deleted from the pool of vacant seats displayed on the auditorium screen. Candidates are advised to be present in the Counselling Hall and wait for their turn as per inter-se merit. If a candidate is not available when called, the next candidate on the merit list would be called for allotment of seat and the absent candidate may miss his/her chance of merit-based seat allotment.

- 8. However, if a candidate of higher merit reports late during the process of counselling, and seeks admission against seats vacant (of a particular category to which he/she belongs) at the time of reporting, would get a preference for admission over the candidates with lower rank present at that point of time. The decision of the admission centre in-charge shall be final and binding in this regard.
- 9. Confirmation of the allotted seat to the candidate is subject to the submission of the requisite Institute admission fees. The candidate is required to pay fees through online on web portal https://spce.qviple.com, or Demand Draft in favour of Principal, "Sardar Patel College of Engineering, Andheri" payable at Mumbai.

Reserved category students are required to produce Income Certificate from Tahsildar office for the year 2024-25.

Note:-

- a. The reserved category students eligible to apply for scholarship will have to apply to MahaDBT portal of Government of Maharashtra to avail the scholarship benefit. If the students do not apply to this portal for scholarship/if the scholarship benefit is denied to any student by the competent authority for any reason, whatsoever, the student will have to pay the full fee as applicable to the Open Category Students.
- b. Government Resolutions published from time to time in this regard, will be applicable and binding to all the students.
- 10. If a candidate fails to pay the prescribed institute admission fees at the time of seat allotment, then his/her seat allotment will be cancelled and the seat will be allotted to the next candidate on the merit list. Part Payment or Payment through cash/cheque will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 11. Candidates already admitted to SPCE in CAP Rounds, in the Second Year (Direct Admission) Engineering Programme for AY 2025-26, who are aspiring for branch change should also remain present in person and furnish the original admission confirmation letter issued by SPCE.
- 12. Mere participation in the Counselling Round and paying the registration fees doesn't guarantee the confirmation of admission in the Institute.
- 13. Candidate shall not be entitled to any refund of his/her fees except the Security Deposit and Caution Money Deposit if the online cancellation if effected by the candidate after 5.00 p.m. of the cut-off dated prescribed by the Competent Authority i.e., 13th September 2025.
