SP Learning Initiative for Career Enhancement (SPLICE) – May 2018
A Finishing School initiative by Training & Placement Office

SP Learning Initiative for Career enhancement (SPLICE) is an initiative which aims to equip students with the essentials to be employed. As a part of this initiative, T & P Office conducted an Induction Program and Mock Tests before start of placement season of 2019 Batch UG and PG Students. The schedule of this program is attached with this report.

The induction program was conducted by T & P Officer, Dr. Rahul Dahatonde on July 4th, 2018 at SPJIMR Auditorium. More than 200 students from UG and PG batch of 2019 attended this program. During this program students were briefed the details about their Placements. The placement registration procedures, selection process of various companies, the skills expected by companies, institute placement policy, etc. was discussed in this session. The doubts students had about the overall placements process were addressed. The feedback from various companies about students' performance in previous years' placement drives was also shared with the students. The students were also briefed about how to prepare their resume and do's and don'ts of group discussion and personal interviews.

On the 5th and 6th of July 2018, mock aptitude tests and mock technical tests were conducted for the UG and PG students. The tests were of the similar pattern as those conducted by recruiters. The aptitude test consisted of 3 main modules: Quantitative Aptitude, Logical thinking and reasoning skills and English Usage (verbal) skills.

This pre-placement initiative helped students to become placements-ready.
