



4. **Documentation:** A technical paper presentation often includes slides or written materials that serve as documentation of the research, making it easier for the peers to refer to the work and work upon it.

5. **Career Advancement:** Successful technical paper presentations can contribute to career growth, particularly in academics, where publications and presentations are the key components of a researcher's portfolio.

Why to write a Technical Paper?

The Speaker explained that a TPP is made to present the work to the community and claim ownership of one's own work.

Key learnings to make a Technical Paper Presentation:

1. The speaker emphasized that format is important, because it differentiates between institutions on how a TPP is conducted.

2. Following is the order: Title of the Research, Survey or Experimentation; Tools used (methodology).


One must explain all assumptions, provide all useful scales to give appropriate level of information.

4. There is a need of making columns, so that one easily read the message to be conveyed.

5. The abstract should be summarized, eye-catching and original, as the paper requires creditable reference. Journal paper is one such example.
